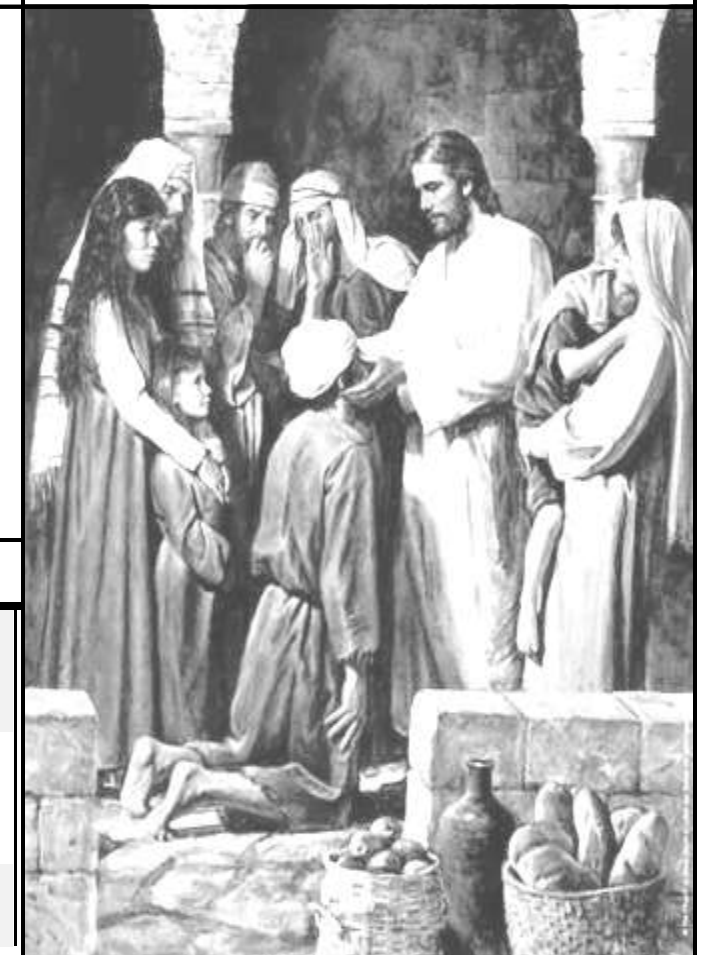

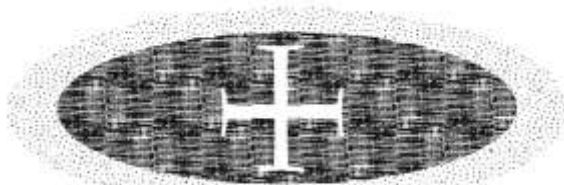

Today, I appeal to you to give generously next weekend to the National Collection for The Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C. As the only institution of higher education founded by the U.S. bishops and chartered by the Vatican, Catholic University is the national university of the Catholic Church, charged with educating the future leaders of the Church, the nation, and the world.


- **Catholic University serves the Church** by engaging its students to discover knowledge and truth through excellence in teaching and research. 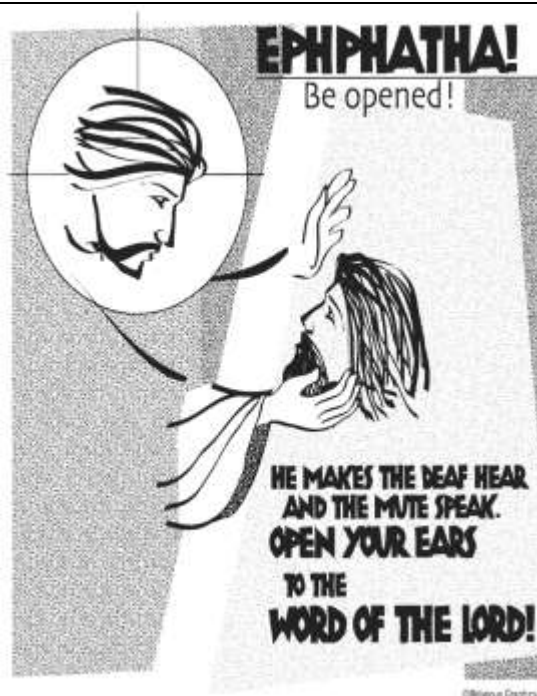
